Bids will be awarded at the next regularly scheduled Board Meeting of the Board of County Road Commissioners following the due date for receipt of bids.

## SPECIFICATIONS

The above material must meet current Michigan Department of Transportation specifications or Lenawee County Road Commission specifications.

Asphalt cement is to be delivered at 300-degree application rate to the job site in Lenawee County.

Material will be F.O.B. plant site, located at 9293 Round Lake Highway Manitou Beach, Michigan 49253, approx. one mile north of US-223; all units must be self-unloading.

The Lenawee County Road Commission does not pay demurrage and all bids must be submitted without demurrage charges.

Bidder must specify the name(s) of each proposed freight hauler and bid minimum size loads only.

Bidder's proposed freight hauler must be approved by the Lenawee County Road Commission before acceptance of the bid.

All proposals to be received in sealed envelopes bearing the name of the bidder and plainly marked on the outside as to contents.

Weather conditions and other factors may increase or decrease the amount of material required for seasonal requirements. Bidders are expected to supply seasonal requirements in whatever amount required by the Road Commission which may be less than or greater than any estimate provided. Bidders may obtain information on past use of material by contacting the Road Commission offices.

Bidders must bid either (1) a maximum Asphalt Cement price (ceiling price) with abatement in price as market conditions warrant; or (2) a firm price throughout the 2016 paving season. Bidders with an anticipated abatement are advised to bid their best ceiling price, as no adjustment will be allowed until after the bid is awarded.

Each successful bidder will be required to execute a "customer – supplier" agreement with the Road Commission detailing the expectations and course of dealing expected of both the supplier and the Road Commission. The agreement shall be in a form selected by the Road Commission. Copies of a sample customer – supplier agreement may be obtained at the Lenawee County Road Commission office at the above address.

Notification of the bid award will be mailed to each bidder on the next business day following the Board Meeting and that information is not available until that time.

The right is reserved to accept or reject any or all bids or any part of same, to waive irregularities and/or informalities in bids and to make the award in whole or in part as may appear to be in the best interests of the Lenawee County Road Commission and Lenawee County.
