SPECIFICATIONS

This proposal is for the resurfacing of the Adrian Facility parking garage floor.

The proposal shall include the follow:

Floor preparation of steel shot blasting, crack and seam preparation, and floor leveling.

Primer/ adhesion base for epoxy overlayment

Epoxy overlayment system that is ¼ inch thick that provides smooth, compact, dense, shock resistant floor.

Epoxy top coat including primer. Primer should be minimum of 5 mil and top coat 15 mil with a light gray color. Slip resistance also in top coat.

4" Epoxy safety yellow lines for parking spots
